Safety Instruction Guide for BERETTA 92 MAGAZINE BLUED STEEL 18RD

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the BERETTA 92 MAGAZINE BLUED STEEL 18RD. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines to ensure safe usage and maintenance of your magazine. Please read this document carefully before using the product.

- Push the magazine firmly into the well until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine:

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction and the safety is engaged.
- Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
- Grasp the magazine and pull it straight out of the magazine well.

4. Unloading the Magazine:

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
- Remove the magazine from the firearm.
- Press down on the cartridges from the top while tilting the magazine to allow them to slide out.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of damaged or worn magazines in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not throw magazines in regular trash. Instead, contact your local waste management facility for proper disposal methods.
- Ensure that all ammunition is removed before disposing of the magazine.
