# Safety Instruction Guide for HEAVY WEIGHT NYLON CENTERFIRE RIFLE BORE BRUSH

## Introduction

  6. Clean the bore brush after use and store it in a safe place.

- Dispose of the bore brush in accordance with local regulations for nonhazardous waste.
