Safety Instruction Guide for HEAVY WEIGHT NYLON CENTERFIRE RIFLE BORE BRUSH

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the HEAVY WEIGHT NYLON CENTERFIRE RIFLE BORE BRUSH. This product is designed to effectively clean your rifle bore while ensuring safety during use. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to understand how to use the product safely and effectively.
