# Safety Instruction Guide for AR15/M16 223 Wylde Match Barrels

## Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the AR15/M16 223 Wylde Match Barrels by White Oak Armament. - The barrel has a 17 twist rate, which is optimized for stabilizing heavier bullets. Use appropriate ammunition for best performance.
- Ensure the gas system length is compatible with your firearm's configuration (MidLength or RifleLength).

- Ensure the firearm is completely unloaded.
- Remove the existing barrel according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Align the new barrel with the upper receiver and ensure it fits securely.
