Training pistol with the look, feel and approximate weight of a Glock 17/22 provides enhanced dry-fire practice. The Shot Indicating Resetting Trigger (SIRT) system assists shooters in developing proper grip and trigger control without spending money on ammunition. Auto-resetting trigger activates two red lasers – one when pressure is applied to the trigger to serve as a take-up/trigger prep indicator (may be deactivated), while the other displays “shot” placement. Features standard sights and a functional magazine release that enables users to practice reloads using the included weighted training magazine.

SIRT Performer Training Pistol Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SIRT Performer Training Pistol. This training pistol is designed to enhance your dryfire practice while ensuring safety and compliance with EU regulations. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use of the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat the training pistol as if it were a real firearm.
- Keep the training pistol pointed in a safe direction at all times.
- Do not place your finger on the trigger until you are ready to shoot.

- Grip the training pistol firmly with both hands.
- Ensure that your finger is off the trigger until you are ready to practice.
- Apply pressure to the trigger to activate the red lasers:
 - The first laser indicates trigger prep (may be deactivated).
 - The second laser indicates shot placement.
- Practice your grip and trigger control without the need for live ammunition.

3. Practice Reloads:

- Use the included weighted training magazine for practicing reloads.
- Press the magazine release button to remove the magazine.
- Insert the weighted training magazine back into the training pistol until it clicks into place.

4. Cleaning and Maintenance:

- Regularly clean the training pistol with a soft, dry cloth.
- Avoid using any harsh chemicals or solvents that may damage the surface.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the training pistol and any accessories in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the training pistol in regular household waste.
- Remove the battery before disposal and recycle it according to local battery recycling guidelines.
