Does not contain a pistol grip. The B-GC Geissele Competition Trigger is available ONLY from Brownells and was developed to produce a short, relatively light single-stage pull with a short, quick reset that are ideal for 3 Gun competition and recreational target shooting. Two trigger springs are included so the B-GC can be set up with a 3.2 lb. or 4 lb. pull. The B-GC trigger is not recommended for benchrest shooting or shooting that requires small groups. It is designed for competition involving rapid target engagement.
