The firing pin holes on all diamond series slides and top ends are reamed to take the 9mm / 38 super firing pin, as with all custom grade slides. This slide has the 45 ACP or 9mm/38 Super breech face cut so will work with all of the 45 cartridge groups, 45 acp, 45 Super, 400 Corbon, 460...etc.. or all the 9mm / 38 super cartridge group (9x19, 9x21, 9x23, 38 Super, etc)
