The government (A1 style) Frame is the more tradition 1911 pistol style with mil spec hammer, safeties and arched mainspring housing. 45 acp Ejector also installed and pinned in place. Available in checkered, 20LPI. Manufactured to the original and more desirable 70 Series Colt platform. Will also work with 70 or 80 series slides. This is a high-quality Fusion Firearms 1911 Lower assembly with parts blended and fitted before the finish is applied. FFL Required for drop shipment to your FFL dealer for pick-up. May require gunsmith fitting.
