- Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
- Pull the magazine straight out of the magazine well.

4. Disassembling the Magazine for Cleaning

- Ensure the magazine is unloaded before disassembly.

- Locate the specially designed base plate at the bottom of the magazine.
- Press down on the base plate and slide it off to access the interior components.
- Clean the magazine body and follower with a soft cloth and appropriate cleaning solution.
- Reassemble the magazine by sliding the base plate back into place until it clicks.
