Easy to manipulate, it combines a handy size and innovative ramp shape. By changing the orientation you choose from three different wedge sizes to get the rough elevation support you need. Then, small lateral movements combined with flexing the bag with your hand allow for fine tuning, giving you precise control over the amount of rear-end support. Color: Black, Dry Earth Material: 1000 Denier Cordura Style: Wedge This simple system provides for an infinite range of fine elevation changes, from near-ground to 5 ½ inches Made of 1000 denier nylon, with 25mm webbing straps on three of its sides. Use the latter to hang it from your pack or range bag, or simply sling it over your rifle barrel if you need to make a quick movement.
