Safety Instruction Guide for AR15 MIKE9 ULTRALIGHT BARREL 9MM

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the AR15 MIKE9 ULTRALIGHT BARREL 9MM from Foxtrot Mike Products. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure safe use and maintenance of your product. - Remove the existing barrel from the upper receiver according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Align the Mike9 9mm Ultralight Barrel with the upper receiver.
- Securely fasten the barrel using the appropriate tools, ensuring a tight fit without overtorquing.
- Attach any muzzle devices or suppressors that are compatible with the 1/236 TPI threads.

2. Usage

- Load the firearm with compatible 9mm Luger ammunition.

- Maintain proper stance and grip to manage recoil effectively.
- After use, clean the barrel according to the manufacturer's recommendations to ensure longevity and performance.
