Safety Instruction Guide for the SR15 E3 MOD 2 MLOK 5.56

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Knights Armament SR15 E3 MOD 2 MLOK 5.56 rifle. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use of your rifle. Please read and understand these instructions before handling or using the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat the rifle as if it is loaded, even if you believe it is not.

- After firing, engage the safety and remove the magazine if the rifle will not be used immediately.

- Dispose of any used ammunition casings and packaging in accordance with local regulations.
- If the rifle is no longer in use, consider turning it in to a licensed dealer or law enforcement agency for safe disposal.
- Do not dispose of the rifle in regular household waste.
