There's an anti-reflection coating on the inner surface of the lenses to improve clarity, and polarized, non-polarized, mirrored and non-mirrored options are available. Clear lenses are great for shooting and indoor use and are best-suited for use in low-light situations. Bronze with blue mirroring is a great do-it-all lens for outdoor use and does well in full-sun situations, thanks to its 15-percent light transmission. Rose-colored lenses are ideally suited for shooting, thanks to their increased contrast and 38-percent light transmission. Finally, Magpul offers a gray with silver mirroring option in its Helix lineup, which is set up for very bright light conditions and features a 11.4-percent light transmission.
