The M-BRACE Scope Mounting System embodies an evolutionary step taken from ARC's successful M10 Scope Rings that have served thousands of riflemen for over a decade. It is an engineered product standing alone in stark contrast to the conveniently designed gadgets for which engineering was never a consideration. NOTE: When attached to the far aft recoil slot in the picatinny rail on an action with 90 degree bolt rotation, the 32mm height M-BRACE serrated interface block may interfere with the bolt handle when opened. This issue can usually be avoided by moving the mount forward 1 slot in the picatinny rail. Torque spec: 6.2 Nm (55 in-lbs) on scope clamp and rail mount screws. Torque spec: 3.4 Nm (30 in-lbs) on bubble level screw.

MBRACE Scope Mount Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MBRACE Scope Mount from American Rifle Company. This guide provides important safety information to ensure the proper use and maintenance of your scope mount. Please read this guide carefully before installation and use to promote safe practices.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure safe use of the MBRACE Scope Mount by following all instructions provided in this guide.
- Be aware of potential hazards associated with the use of scope mounts, including but not limited to:
 - Improper installation leading to scope misalignment or failure.
 - Interference with the bolt handle when using certain rifle actions.
- Always check for product recalls or safety notices on the EU Safety Gate platform.

Specific Safety Precautions for Use

- Do not exceed the specified torque settings:
 - 6.2 Nm (55 inlbs) on scope clamp and rail mount screws.
 - 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs) on bubble level screw.
- When attaching the mount to the far aft recoil slot on a picatinny rail with a 90degree bolt rotation, ensure that the 32mm height MBRACE serrated interface block does not interfere with the bolt handle.
- If interference occurs, reposition the mount forward by 1 slot in the picatinny rail to avoid potential accidents.
- Regularly inspect the mount for signs of wear or damage before each use.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Ensure that the rifle is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction before beginning installation.
- Select the appropriate picatinny rail slot for mounting.
- Align the MBRACE Scope Mount with the selected slot on the picatinny rail.
- Securely fasten the scope clamp and rail mount screws to the specified torque settings (6.2 Nm or 55 inlbs).
- Install the bubble level screw and tighten to 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs).
- Check for proper alignment and stability of the scope mount.

2. Usage:

- Always verify that the scope is securely mounted before use.
- Avoid using the rifle in conditions that may compromise the integrity of the scope mount.
- If you notice any unusual behavior or looseness in the mount during use, stop immediately and inspect the mount.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the MBRACE Scope Mount in accordance with local regulations regarding electronic waste and materials.
- Do not dispose of the product in regular household waste. Instead, contact local waste management authorities for guidance on proper disposal methods.
