It is an engineered product standing alone in stark contrast to the conveniently designed gadgets for which engineering was never a consideration. NOTE: When attached to the far aft recoil slot in the picatinny rail on an action with 90 degree bolt rotation, the 32mm height M-BRACE serrated interface block may interfere with the bolt handle when opened. This issue can usually be avoided by moving the mount forward 1 slot in the picatinny rail. Torque spec: 6.2 Nm (55 in-lbs) on scope clamp and rail mount screws. Torque spec: 3.4 Nm (30 in-lbs) on bubble level screw.

- If interference occurs, move the mount forward 1 slot in the picatinny rail to avoid this issue.
- Always follow the specified torque specifications when tightening screws:
 - 6.2 Nm (55 inlbs) on scope clamp and rail mount screws.
 - 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs) on the bubble level screw.
- Inspect the installation regularly to ensure all components remain secure.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation

- Choose a suitable location on the picatinny rail for mounting the scope.
- Align the MBRACE Scope Mount with the desired slot on the picatinny rail.
- Insert the screws and tighten them to the specified torque:
 - Scope clamp and rail mount screws: 6.2 Nm (55 inlbs).
 - Bubble level screw: 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs).
- Check that the mount is firmly attached and does not move.

2. Usage

- Ensure the firearm is unloaded before attaching or detaching the scope mount.
- After installation, check the alignment of the scope and make necessary adjustments.
- Always verify that the scope mount is secure before firing the firearm.
- Regularly inspect the mount during use to ensure it remains securely fastened.
