The M-BRACE Scope Mounting System embodies an evolutionary step taken from ARC's successful M10 Scope Rings that have served thousands of riflemen for over a decade. It is an engineered product standing alone in stark contrast to the conveniently designed gadgets for which engineering was never a consideration. NOTE: When attached to the far aft recoil slot in the picatinny rail on an action with 90 degree bolt rotation, the 32mm height M-BRACE serrated interface block may interfere with the bolt handle when opened. This issue can usually be avoided by moving the mount forward 1 slot in the picatinny rail. Torque spec: 6.2 Nm (55 in-lbs) on scope clamp and rail mount screws. Torque spec: 3.4 Nm (30 in-lbs) on bubble level screw.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Installation:

- Ensure you have the following tools ready: a torque wrench and appropriate screwdrivers.
- Identify the Picatinny rail on your rifle and ensure it is clean and free from debris.
- Position the MBRACE Scope Mount on the rail, ensuring the serrated interface block is aligned correctly.
- **Note:** When attached to the far aft recoil slot, be aware that the 32mm height may interfere with the bolt handle. If this occurs, move the mount forward by one slot.
- Tighten the scope clamp and rail mount screws to a torque specification of 6.2 Nm (55 inlbs).
- Tighten the bubble level screw to a torque specification of 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs).

### 2. Usage:

- Once installed, ensure that the scope is securely mounted and aligned.

- Regularly check the mount and scope for any signs of looseness or misalignment.
- Always handle the rifle and scope mount with care and ensure proper safety measures are in place when using firearms.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of the MBACE Scope Mount responsibly according to local regulations.
- If the product is deemed unsafe or damaged, do not attempt to use it. Follow local guidelines for disposal of metal and plastic components.
