The M-BRACE Scope Mounting System embodies an evolutionary step taken from ARC's successful M10 Scope Rings that have served thousands of riflemen for over a decade. It is an engineered product standing alone in stark contrast to the conveniently designed gadgets for which engineering was never a consideration. NOTE: When attached to the far aft recoil slot in the picatinny rail on an action with 90 degree bolt rotation, the 32mm height M-BRACE serrated interface block may interfere with the bolt handle when opened. This issue can usually be avoided by moving the mount forward 1 slot in the picatinny rail. Torque spec: 6.2 Nm (55 in-lbs) on scope clamp and rail mount screws. Torque spec: 3.4 Nm (30 in-lbs) on bubble level screw.

MBRACE Scope Mount Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MBRACE Scope Mount from American Rifle Company. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines to ensure the safe and effective use of your scope mount. Please read this document carefully before installation and use.

General Safety Guidelines

Move the mount forward 1 slot to avoid this issue.
- **Torque Specifications:**
 - Use a torque of 6.2 Nm (55 inlbs) on the scope clamp and rail mount screws.
 - Use a torque of 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs) on the bubble level screw.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check the tightness of all screws and the integrity of the mount during use, especially after heavy usage or exposure to harsh conditions.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation:

- Ensure that your rifle is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction before beginning installation.
- Gather all necessary tools, including a torque wrench.

2. Installation Steps:

- Align the MBRACE Scope Mount with the desired position on the picatinny rail.
- Carefully attach the mount, ensuring it is securely placed.
- Use the torque wrench to tighten the scope clamp and rail mount screws to the specified torque of 6.2 Nm (55 inlbs).
- Tighten the bubble level screw to a torque of 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs).

3. Usage:

- Once installed, check the alignment of your scope and make any necessary adjustments.
- Test the function of the bolt handle to ensure there is no interference.
- Regularly inspect the mount during use to ensure it remains secure.

- When the MBRACE Scope Mount reaches the end of its lifespan, dispose of it in accordance with local regulations for electronic and mechanical waste.
- Do not dispose of the scope mount in regular household waste.
