Precision machined from hardened steel with Picatinny slot-and-rail spacing that allows fast and simple changes to eye relief, plus great flexibility in scope choice. Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Heavy Duty (HD) mounts are .100" lower than the Lightweight mounts to minimize weight and keep your optic closer to the barrel centerline for improved accuracy. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to  $\pm .002$ ". Machined from ultra-rigid 4140 carbon steel pre-hardened to Rc 35-35 before machining. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite.

# Safety Instruction Guide for REMINGTON 700, 722, 40X SHORT ACTION STEEL HD SCOPE BASES

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the EGW Remington 700, 722, 40X Short Action Steel Scope Bases. - Apply a drip of blue Loctite to each screw to ensure they remain secure.

- Once installed, attach your chosen scope using Picatinny or Weaver rings.
- Adjust the eye relief as needed to ensure optimal sight alignment.
- Regularly inspect the scope bases and screws for tightness and any signs of wear.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any packaging materials in accordance with local regulations.
- When the scope bases reach the end of their life cycle, dispose of them as metal waste at a designated

recycling facility.

- Ensure that all components are disposed of safely to prevent harm to the environment.
