Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Lightweight Tactical mounts have a milled center channel for weight reduction. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to +/- .002". Machined from ultra-rigid, extruded 6061 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting.

# **Safety Instruction Guide for REMINGTON 700, 721, 725 LONG ACTION SCOPE BASES**

## **Introduction**

- Attach your Picatinny or Weaver scope rings to the mounted scope base.
- Ensure that the scope is adjusted to your preferred eye relief and is securely fastened.

### **4. Final Inspection:**

- Check that all screws are tight and that the scope is properly aligned.
- Perform a visual inspection of the installation to ensure everything is in place.

## 5. Usage:
