Introduction

- The flat edge of the flag head can be used on scope windage and elevation knobs instead of a slot head screwdriver.

3. Removing the Chamber Safety Flag

- Open the action of the firearm.
- Gently pull the flag out of the chamber.
- Store the flag in a safe place when not in use.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or worn Chamber Safety Flags responsibly.
- Follow local regulations for the disposal of plastic materials.
- If the flag is no longer needed, consider recycling it where facilities exist.
