Introduction

Thank you for choosing the TRAUMA KIT NOW! SMALL from Blue Force Gear. This compact medical pouch is designed to provide essential trauma supplies in an easycarry format. It is crucial to understand how to use this kit safely and effectively to ensure the best outcomes in emergency situations.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always inspect the trauma kit before use to ensure all components are intact and within their expiration dates.
- Keep the trauma kit out of reach of children to prevent accidental use or ingestion of items.
- Store the kit in a cool, dry place to maintain the integrity of the medical supplies.

5. Using the Hypothermia Blanket:

- Unfold the blanket and wrap it around the injured person, ensuring full coverage.

6. Using Flat Fold Tape:

- Cut a piece of tape to the required length.
- Apply the tape to secure dressings or gauze in place.

7. Using Compressed Gauze:

- Remove the gauze from the kit.
- Pack the gauze into the wound as needed and secure with tape.
