# **Safety Instruction Guide for Brownells AR15 Magazines**

## **Introduction**

Thank you for purchasing the Brownells AR15 223/5.56mm 30 Round Magazine. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use and handling of your magazine. Please read and understand the information provided to avoid any risks associated with the use of this product.

- When finished shooting, remove the magazine carefully and ensure it is unloaded.

### **4. Unloading the Magazine:**

- Remove the magazine from the firearm.
- Push the follower down to release the cartridges, or remove them one at a time.
- Store the magazine in a safe location once unloaded.

- Dispose of the magazine in accordance with local regulations.

- Consider recycling the aluminum material if local facilities allow.
