# Safety Instruction Guide for HERRING MODEL 2024 300 AAC BLACKOUT LEVER ACTION RIFLE

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the HERRING MODEL 2024 300 AAC BLACKOUT LEVER ACTION RIFLE. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use and handling of your rifle. Please read this guide thoroughly and keep it for future reference.
