Safety Instruction Guide for SMITH & WESSON SHIELD MAGAZINES 9MM

Introduction

 3. Continue loading rounds one at a time until you reach the maximum capacity of 7 rounds.
- To remove the magazine from the firearm, press the magazine release button and pull the magazine out.
- To unload the magazine, follow these steps:
 1. Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
 2. Remove the magazine from the firearm.
 3. Press the rounds out of the magazine from the bottom, or use the firearm to eject rounds.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine responsibly and in accordance with local regulations.
- If the magazine is damaged or no longer usable, contact your local waste management facility for proper

disposal methods.

- Do not dispose of magazines in regular household waste.
