Introduction

- After loading, insert the magazine into the firearm as described above.
- Follow the firearm manufacturer's instructions for firing and handling.

3. Unloading

- Remove the magazine by pressing the magazine release button.
- If necessary, manually clear any rounds from the chamber before inspecting the magazine.
