Tungsten Super Shot (TSS) has a 22% heavier density than heavyweight shot and a 56% heavier density than traditional lead shot. It puts the maximum amount of pellets possible in a 10" circle at 40 yds. The Heavyweight TSS shells will include the Flite Control Flex™ wad that gives hunters the ability to shoot any choke tube they prefer. Long-range turkeys don't stand a chance. *No Steel Shot Larger than #4 may be used in Carlson's Turkey Choke Tubes

Safety Instruction Guide for TSS Turkey Beretta/Benelli Choke Tubes

Introduction

Thank you for choosing Carlson's TSS Turkey Choke Tubes designed for Beretta and Benelli shotguns. This guide provides essential safety information and instructions for the safe use and maintenance of your choke tubes.
