Choose between left or right-side installation (or both), in either an upwards or downwards sweep. The downward sweep protects your hand from busting knuckles on optic mounts and other accessories by angling the charging handle down and away from the top of the weapon. Scarging Handles are constructed of low carbon steel and finished with black Nitride or FDE Cerakote made 100% in the USA. Fits all Non-Reciprocating Charging Handle (NRCH) model FN Scars ONLY.
