Safety Instruction Guide for INLINE BULLET FEED MAGAZINE

Introduction

 - Large Inline Bullet Feed Magazine: .390 to .463 diameter (40 CAL, 45 CAL)
- Always wear appropriate eye and ear protection when reloading ammunition.
- Avoid wearing loose clothing or jewelry that may get caught in equipment during use.
- Do not attempt to modify or alter the magazine in any way.
- Ensure that the reloading area is clean and free of obstructions.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Ensure that the reloading press is turned off and unplugged before installing the magazine.
- Align the magazine with the reloading press according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Secure the magazine in place, ensuring it is firmly attached and does not move.
