Introduction

Thank you for choosing the H027 Homesteader 9mm Luger Rifle Magazine by Henry Repeating Arms. This guide provides essential safety instructions and usage guidelines to ensure your safe and effective use of this product. Please read and follow these instructions carefully.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always handle the magazine and firearm with care, treating them as if they are loaded.
- Store the magazine in a secure location, out of reach of children and unauthorized users.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

- Insert the magazine into the magazine well of the rifle until it clicks into place.
- Confirm that the magazine is securely attached by gently pulling down on it.

2. Loading the Magazine:

- With the magazine removed from the rifle, press down on the follower to create space for the rounds.
- Insert one round of 9mm Luger ammunition at a time into the magazine, ensuring that the rounds are oriented correctly.
- Continue loading until the magazine reaches its maximum capacity of 5 rounds.

3. Using the Magazine:

- Reinsert the loaded magazine into the rifle.
- Ensure the firearm is in a safe condition before proceeding to fire.
- Follow standard firearm operation procedures to fire the rifle.

4. Unloading the Magazine:

- Remove the magazine from the rifle.
- Press the follower down and remove the rounds one at a time, or allow the rounds to fall out if the magazine is inverted.
- Store the magazine and ammunition safely after use.
