FHD FLASH HIDERS These fit the plan B type mounts. This is an updated version that has larger wrench flats on the rear. Always use an alignment rod to ensure that the entire system is set up correctly. Make sure all surfaces are cleaned and the muzzle device has been torqued and Rockset to the barrel. Use on a Q can voids your warranty, be warned. Torque the muzzle device to approximately 30 ft lbs. Make sure the muzzle device is square against the shoulder. When setting the silencer on the muzzle device, ensure that the threads and tapers are clean. Torque the suppressor to 10 ft lbs. Ensure alignment. Enjoy. The nitride finish does lead to a tighter seal, with that said, it is extremely important to torque and rockset your muzzle device to the barrel properly. FEATURES: 17-4 PH H900 Atlas and Atlas XL Compatible Plan B Compatible Atlas XL Adapter No Overrun Black Nitride Finish (67 HRC Surface Hardness) Shims Not Included, if you would like to specifically time this, shims will be required. Note: your barrel may require a shim if the manufacturer did not put a thread relief on it.

FHD Flash Hiders Safety Instructions

Introduction

- The nitride finish provides a tighter seal; therefore, proper torque and installation are crucial.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation

- Gather all necessary tools, including a torque wrench and alignment rod.
- Ensure that the firearm is unloaded and in a safe condition before beginning installation.

2. Installation Steps

- Clean the muzzle device and ensure that all threads and tapers are free from debris.
- Align the muzzle device with the barrel and handtighten it first.
- Use a torque wrench to tighten the muzzle device to approximately 30 ftlbs.
- Ensure that the muzzle device is square against the shoulder.
- If using shims for timing, ensure they are installed according to the manufacturer's specifications.

3. Attaching the Suppressor

- Once the muzzle device is secured, clean the threads of the suppressor.
- Align the suppressor with the muzzle device and handtighten.
- Use a torque wrench to tighten the suppressor to 10 ftlbs.
- Confirm that the suppressor is properly aligned and secure.

4. PostInstallation Check

- Doublecheck all connections and ensure that everything is properly torqued.
- Conduct a visual inspection to confirm that there are no loose parts.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the product in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the product in regular household waste.
