Safety Instruction Guide for Redding Competition Seater Die

Introduction

- To set your preferred seating depth, use the zero set feature to calibrate the micrometer accordingly.

3. Seating Bullets:

- Place a clean brass case into the reloading press.
- Insert the bullet into the case mouth.
- Pull the handle of the press to seat the bullet. Monitor the process closely to ensure proper seating.

4. PostUse:

- After use, clean the die to remove any residue or debris.
- Store the die in a safe, dry place away from moisture and extreme temperatures.
