Introduction

2. Installing the Magazine into the Firearm:

- With the firearm pointed in a safe direction, ensure it is on safe mode.
- Align the magazine with the magazine well of the firearm.
- Push the magazine firmly until it clicks into place.
- Verify the magazine is securely attached before proceeding.

3. Removing the Magazine:

- Point the firearm in a safe direction.
- Press the magazine release button while pulling the magazine downward.
- Inspect the magazine for any damage or debris before reloading.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the magazine in regular household waste.

- If the magazine is damaged or no longer functional, consider recycling the metal components where possible.
