# 3Gun Competition Cleaning System Safety Instructions

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the 3Gun Competition Cleaning System by OTIS. This ultracompact cleaning kit is designed specifically for 3gun competitors, providing essential tools for maintaining your firearms. To ensure safe and effective use of this product, please read and follow the safety instructions outlined in this guide.

## General Safety Guidelines

- Always handle firearms with care and adhere to all safety protocols.
- Ensure that the cleaning area is wellventilated to avoid inhalation of any fumes from solvents or cleaners.
- Keep the cleaning kit out of reach of children and unauthorized users.
- Regularly inspect the cleaning tools for any signs of wear or damage before use.
- Do not use the product for any purpose other than its intended use as a cleaning kit for firearms.
- Be aware of potential hazards associated with the materials used in the cleaning kit, including solvents and sharp tools.

- Dispose of used cotton patches and any cleaning materials according to local regulations to prevent environmental contamination.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Preparation

- Ensure that the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Gather all necessary tools from the cleaning kit, including the flexible cleaning cables, slotted tips, brushes, and the O85® Ultra Bore Solvent®.

### 2. Cleaning a Firearm

- For rifles (.223/5.56mm):
  1. Attach the appropriate slotted tip to the flexible cable.
  2. Apply a small amount of O85® Ultra Bore Solvent® to a cotton patch.
  3. Insert the patch into the slotted tip and run it through the bore from the chamber to the muzzle.
  4. Follow with a bore brush to scrub the interior of the barrel.
  5. Repeat the process until the bore is clean.
- For pistols (9mm/40/45):
  1. Follow the same steps as for rifles, using the appropriate caliber slotted tips and brushes.
  2. Pay special attention to the chamber and feed ramp areas.
- For shotguns (12 gauge):
  1. Use the shotgun patch saver and bore brushes to clean the barrel.
  2. Ensure that all debris is removed from the chamber and barrel.

### 3. **PostCleaning**

- After cleaning, run a dry cotton patch through the bore to remove any residual solvent.
- Store the cleaning kit in a safe, dry place, preferably in the nylon carry case provided.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of used cotton patches, brushes, and any other cleaning materials in accordance with local regulations.
- Empty solvent containers should be disposed of as hazardous waste where applicable.
- Do not dispose of cleaning materials in regular household waste.
