Inside the Beretta 92F steel magazine, consumers will find a dependable magazine spring made from heat-treated chrome-silicon wire and topped with an injection-molded follower. The magazines are all made in the USA.

# Safety Instruction Guide for BERETTA 92F STEEL MAGAZINE 9MM

## Introduction
