This replaceable cutter head accepts all Lyman pilots. This unit packs a high speed drive and a safety guard for added protection. Lyman's patented Universal Chuckhead can handle any case cutting job from .17 caliber to .458 caliber with no collets or shell holders required. It also comes with nine of the most popular caliber pilots: 22, 24, 27, 28/7mm, 30, 9mm, 35 (38/357), 44 and 45A.

Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction
