Introduction

 - **Reaming Primer Crimp:** Use the reamer attachment for military brass, ensuring you select the correct size for the primer pocket.

- Turn off and unplug the tool.
- Brush all brass chips into the removable collection pan.
- Dispose of any waste materials in accordance with local regulations.
