Tipton Felt Cleaning Pellets Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

- Insert the jag with the pellet into the firearm's bore.
- Push the cleaning pellet through the bore to clean the lands and grooves.
- Repeat the process as necessary until the firearm is clean.

3. PostCleaning:

- After cleaning, ensure all cleaning pellets and materials are disposed of properly.
- Store the cleaning pellets and other cleaning supplies in a safe location.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of used cleaning pellets in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of cleaning pellets in regular household waste if they are classified as hazardous.
- Check with local waste management authorities for specific disposal instructions.
