A convenient storage area incorporated into the front of the base features a removable lid that adds additional clearance when detached, and also acts as a rubberized rear support surface for firing handguns when left in place. Another key features is the front elevation system. A spring loaded tension mechanism and height adjustment knob are great for fast, one handed elevation adjustments to keep the front cradle wobble free thought the entire vertical range. Over-molded front and rear supports protect the firearm's finish, but are firm enough to prevent any give or play. Shooters will enjoy the versatility of converting the Matrix into a compact front rest by removing the rear portion of the frame. Whether used as a front rest or as a full length rest, the Matrix provides stability that will deliver maximum accuracy potential.
